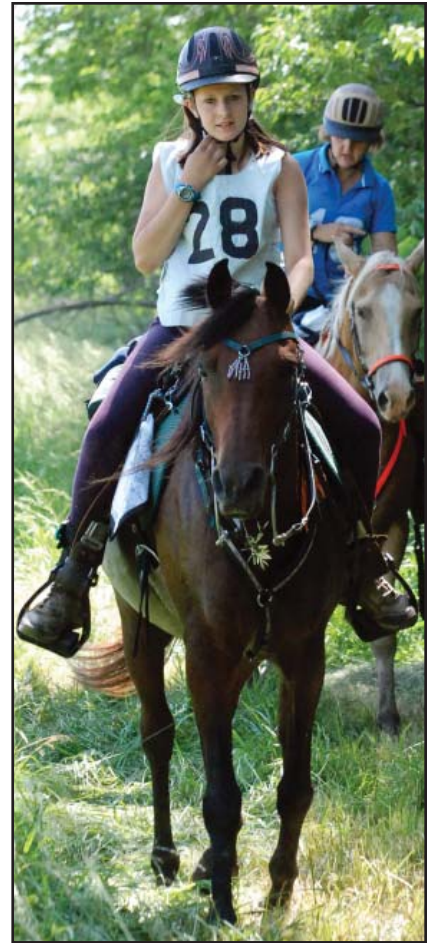

RIDING TO THE RESCUE CTR

Enjoy a wonderful NATRC "A" ride on the trails of Perry State Park at Perry Lake. The equestrian trails wind through upland forest habitat allowing many opportunities for viewing wildlife and colorful vegetation. Shoes recommended but not required.

65 rider limit.

Perry State Park: Has a daily fee and an overnight fee. Please pay at the ranger station as you enter the park. If the station is closed there is a self pay station. Management is not responsible for these fees!

Directions: Perry State Park is located between Lawrence, KS and Topeka, KS on Highway 24. Travel East from Topeka approximately 8 miles, or West from Lawrence approximately 15 miles to Kansas 237 N turn off. Turn north and go 4 miles to the State Park Entrance. Turn left at the ranger station. The ranger station is on the left or the west side of the road. Go down a short hill to a Y in the black top. Take the left fork and go up a short steep hill. At the top of this hill turn right onto a gravel road. There will be another Y. Either fork will take you into the horse park. Water and showers are at the north end of this big loop. Watch for NATRC trail markers and signs.

Primitive Camping: Portable toilets at camp site; showers within walking/driving distance. Horse water available. Limited sites with utilities are available. Please contact the park office to RSVP for utility sites.

Ride Notes: Check-in Friday from 3:00 – 7:00 p.m. Late check-in Sat. AM. PLEASE NOTIFY SECRETARY OF LATE ARRIVAL. Ride Briefing at 8:00 p.m. on Friday. New competitor briefing at 7:30 on Friday evening if requested. Negative Coggin's required on ALL horses in camp, including non-competing horses. Health Certificates on all out-of-state horses.

NO DOGS AT MEALS or MEETINGS. Dogs MUST remain on leash at all times.

Ride Fees: All profits benefit the rescued horses of Rainbow Meadows Equine Rescue and Retirement, Inc., near Sedan Kansas. Rainbow Meadows is a 501(c)(3) non-profit public charity. Visit their website at www.rainbowmeadowranch.com for additional information.

All classes/divisions: Adults \$75.00; Juniors \$50.00; non-NATRC members add \$15.00. Everyone adds "ride fees" listed on Ride Entry Form. Sign-up through RMS available.

MEAL DEAL available: \$25.00 – Fri. dinner, Sat. dinner, Sun. lunch. (*Must RSVP by May 28th!*)

Checks are payable to "Rainbow Meadows" - \$40.00 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit plus \$25.00 MEAL DEAL (if desired) fees will hold a spot until May 28, 2010. After May 28, 2010, mail completed entry with total ride fees to Ride Secretary. Contact Ride Secretary ASAP if you must cancel attendance.

Meals must be paid for and reserved NO LATER than May 28, 2010.
